Isla Vista's **Friendship Manor**—home to approximately 200 people 62 years old and over—announced this week that it is **looking to relocate**. The search, however, has proven challenging given the facility's 501(c)(3) tax-exempt property status, which affords its residents less expensive monthly rates. Friendship Manor has said it is open to the idea of **partnering and/or sharing facilities** with an existing senior center.
